## **PUBLIC HEARING: "One Zone Entity" Opened at 7:30pm**

**Barry Smith** – discussed making an amendment to our current Land Use Regulations. There would be 2 basic additions. The language would be similar or exact as " the designation of a district for the purpose of, the entire jurisdiction of the Town of Macomb should be considered as within a single unnamed district and the applicants of this law shall be uniformed throughout the town." The second addition would be the establishment of a Board of Appeals with their responsibilities. The "BAR" Board of Assessment Review Board are willing to fulfill this position. So far, the Planning Board has not had anyone disagreeing with their decision. This way if there is a disagreement there will be a Board to go to. This change will fulfill the Planning Board's responsibility plus the County's, and any disgruntled applicants. **George Blatchley** spoke with Henry Leader, and he suggested we rescind by resolution the previous Town Law and then with a new Resolution of that law with the required changes. They would also have to change the name and date to include one zone. More discussion followed with the Town Board. It was decided that the Planning Board would come up with a draft to present to the Town Board next month. Public Hearing closed at 7:46pm followed by:
