*Adoption of Previous Minutes – **Richard Youngs** motioned to adopt previous minutes. **Shawn Clark 2nd**.

PUBLIC CONCERNS AND COMMENTS:

Mike Chetwin, on behalf of The Historical Association, restated a proposal for finishing off the Gazebo without a concrete pad, 3 rolling doors on each side and a 12' door at each end, so that the town could store some equipment during the winter months.

*After a brief discussion between board members, **Ryan Schermerhorn** motioned to give a check for **\$23,512.45** to the Historical Association to carry out the enclosing of Gazebo as stated by **Mike Chetwin**.

REPORTS:

Bookkeeper- **Jennifer Link** Revenue \$150 Justice, \$30 Building Permits, \$12 Dog Licenses. Scrap Metal \$237.50, Tax close out \$2687. Budget Officer: **Bill Dashnaw**- went over budget line by line. Court Clerk's pay was increased to \$24 per hour. All changes will be made in writing to Town Clerk by September 30 as the Tentative Budget and an official Document.

Bill Dashnaw suggested we pay off the cab chassis so we can receive discount.

***Resolution 2025-9-001 Ryan Schermerhorn** motioned to pay **\$176,850** for cab/chassis if it is favorable. **Rishard Youngs 2nd**.

Building Code: **Tim Tuttle**- Left a Building Permit report with the Board.

Planning Board – **Kathleen VanSant** – Two Sketch Plan reviews were presented; the paperwork went to Canton's Planning Office the next day. Two subdivisions were reviewed, and the applications were approved. One companion was obnoxious and unruly. Clerk questioned how she should have handled the situation. **Richard Youngs** stated that the State Police or Sheriff's office should have been called, **Ryan Schermerhorn** concurred, whenever you feel threatened the authorities should be called immediately.

Dog Control – **Dan Moyer** – related to supervisor that nothing was happening.

Assessor - **Mark Schnorr** - School Tax Bills have gone out and generated several calls. Most questions were related to people's STAR status. August 31st was the deadline to file for small claims assessment review, to date no petitions have been filed. The monthly St. Lawrence County Assessor's meeting was held and most of the meeting was spent talking about the County adopting a new law regarding county tax liens.
