Bookkeeper- **Jennifer Link** left early not present for meeting.

Budget Officer: **Bill Dashnaw**- will resend Budget without the notes; and file tax cap shortly.

Building Code: **Tim Tuttle**- New book of Codes should be coming by Dec 31st. There will be a separate law coming out January 1, 2026, about all new housing will be 100% Electric or Solar. No fossil fuels such as gas, oil, or propane. Tim has 3 applications on his desk. People are coming in for their permits before the new law goes into affect. An entire project is based on the "Date of Permit" and last a year and can be renewed each year. A handful of junk related issues **Henry Leader** taking to County Court 12/15/2025.

Planning Board – **Kathleen VanSant** – There were four subdivisions this month, one parcel off County Route 10 one parcel off, one parcel off, one parcel on Pleasant Lake. One parcel on County Rt 184 must be resubmitted with a survey.

Dog Control – **Dan Moyer** – was not present.

Assessor - **Mark Schnorr** – contacted Creg Systems for help with his laptop. He was having trouble running the V4 Assessment Program. The problem was quickly diagnosed and solved. Creg system is looking into adding an Assessor Town e-mail account. Senior Citizen and Disability with limited income exemption ceiling limits have been changed at the County level. A discussion followed as to when to adopt the new income limits for town taxes.
